

Batting Cage Information

Rules

1. The batting cages **cannot be used for hitting** while games are in progress on either the Goff or O'Day fields. The batting cages can be **used to warm up pitchers**.
2. No food, drink, or chewing gum inside the batting area.
3. No backpacks, book bags, fanny packs, purses, or gym bags may be brought into individual batting cages. You are responsible for all of your valuable and personal items.
4. All children must have adult supervision.
5. Only two people in the batting cage at a time. An adult pitching or feeding the pitching machine and one batter. All others must remain outside the fenced off area.
6. No practice swings outside batting cages.
7. Batters must wear a protective helmet.
8. L-screens must be used at all times.
9. Pitching machine adjustments should not be made with a batter in front of the machine.
10. Pitching machines should not be used in wet weather or extreme wind. At the first sign of rain and or lighting, the machines should be unplugged and returned to the rake room.
11. At the conclusion of each session, each team is responsible for cage cleanup. Cleanup includes: picking up all balls, filling holes near home plate, raking the entire cage area, and picking up any loose debris. Please be sure to accommodate time for this in your schedule.
12. The last team to use the cage is responsible for putting away all equipment.



Policies

1. Patrons enter cage at their own risk.
2. Immediately report any batting cage related injury or facility/equipment irregularity to a league official.
3. Stoughton Youth Baseball reserves the right to adjust the schedule when necessary. Abbreviated schedules may be offered during breaks and holidays.
4. Please ask for assistance in using batting cage equipment with which you are not familiar.

Batting Cage Schedule

Weekday schedule: the batting cages will only be available for those teams which have games scheduled on Goff and O'Day and limited to 30 minutes per team

The teams playing on Goff should utilize the cage closest to the Goff field and the teams playing on O'Day should utilize the cage closest to the O'Day field.

Weekend and school vacation cage times will be limited to 30 minutes per team per day.

On Saturdays due to the number of games being played, the batting cages will only be available for limited use. Please refer to the batting cage schedule posted at the concession stand for details.

On Sundays the batting cages are available on a first-come first-serve basis. A sign-up sheet is posted at the concession stand.
